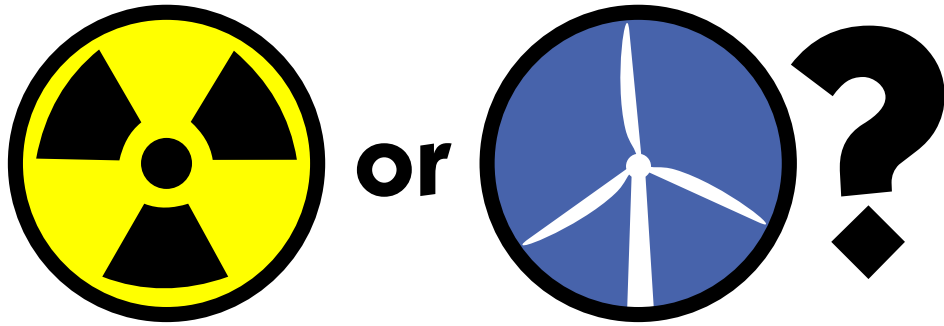


# Which would you prefer?



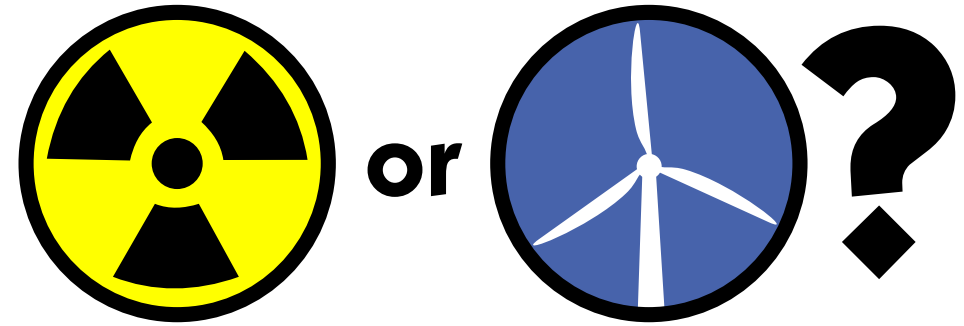
